



OneSchool – Release 2

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At the beginning of Term 4, 2009, OneSchool Release 2 was made available to all teachers in State Schools.

What is new?

Release 2 is made up of the following new components:

- Curriculum Planning
- Specific Educational Requirements
- SET Plans
- Assessment Records, including Teacher Markbooks
- Systemic Records e.g. NAPLAN and EAPs

What does this mean?

There is a lot of new information included in Release 2.

OneSchool has a timeline of 18 months to 3 years for the implementation of Release 2.

This release is idiosyncratic and the nature of its implementation is neither mandatory nor lock step. Therefore it is expected a school principal will decide the appropriate implementation strategy for their school. It is likely complete implementation of the functionality will take 18 months to three years. It is suggested a plan for this implementation should be developed at each individual school and specific staff members or departments are selected to begin using functionality.

Curriculum Planning using OneSchool is not mandatory. If staff do not want to plan using this system, they do not have to. Sharing Unit Plans and other curriculum resources is something that individual teachers have control over.

EQ Support

On Tuesday 27 October, 2009, a GAPS payment for TRS for OneSchool Release Two implementation will be processed. The principal can decide how this TRS is to be used to release staff members for configuration, training and

other implementation activities. The payment will be identified as OneSchool Deployment TRS

QTU Position

TRS funding should be used to ensure that Smart Classroom Coordinators are given time to familiarize themselves with OneSchool Release 2 before providing other staff with Professional Development.

Schools are to make **collaborative** decisions about what elements of OneSchool Release 2 are going to be used by staff. It is not expected that every staff member has to become familiar with every element of OneSchool Release 2 immediately.

That curriculum planning using OneSchool remains voluntary.

That planning does not have to be shared unless a teacher agrees to this.
